



## MUSCARI GROWING GUIDE



**Common Name:** MUSCARI

**Also known as** Grape Hyacinth

**Botanical Name:** Muscari armeniacum **Family Name:** Hyacinthaceae

**Plant Type:** Bulb **Size:** 15cm H x 7cm W

**Planting Time:** Autumn **Planting Width:** 10cm **Depth:** 5cm

**Flowering:** Late Winter to Spring

**Positioning:** Full sun to partial shade

**General Information:** Fully hardy, suitable for all climates except sub/tropical or semi arid.

**Watering:** Only necessary if the ground begins to dry out due to insufficient rainfall.

**Fertilising:** Add organic or chemical fertiliser to ground before planting. Top dress as buds appears.

**Soil:** Well drained.

**Lifting & Storage:** Bulbs can be left undisturbed for many

years. As clumps and borders thicken fertilising becomes important. Dig when foliage turns yellow.

**Pests:** Very hardy to pests and diseases. Bait snails and slugs during growing period.

**Tips:** Plant in long borders as an edging plant.
