

MUSCARI GROWING GUIDE



Common Name: MUSCARI Also known as Grape Hyacinth Botanical Name: Muscari armeniacum Family Name: Hyacinthaceae

Plant Type: Bulb Size: 15cm H x 7cm W

Planting Time: Autumn Planting Width: 10cm Depth: 5cm

Flowering: Late Winter to Spring **Positioning:** Full sun to partial shade

General Information: Fully hardy, suitable for all climates except sub/tropical or semi arid.

Watering: Only necessary if the ground begins to dry out due to insufficient rainfall.

Fertilising: Add organic or chemical fertiliser to ground before planting. Top dress as buds

appears.

Soil: Well drained.

Lifting & Storage: Bulbs can be left undisturbed for many

years. As clumps and borders thicken fertilising becomes important. Dig when foliage turns

yellow.

Pests: Very hardy to pests and diseases. Bait snails and slugs during growing period.

Tips: Plant in long borders as an edging plant.
